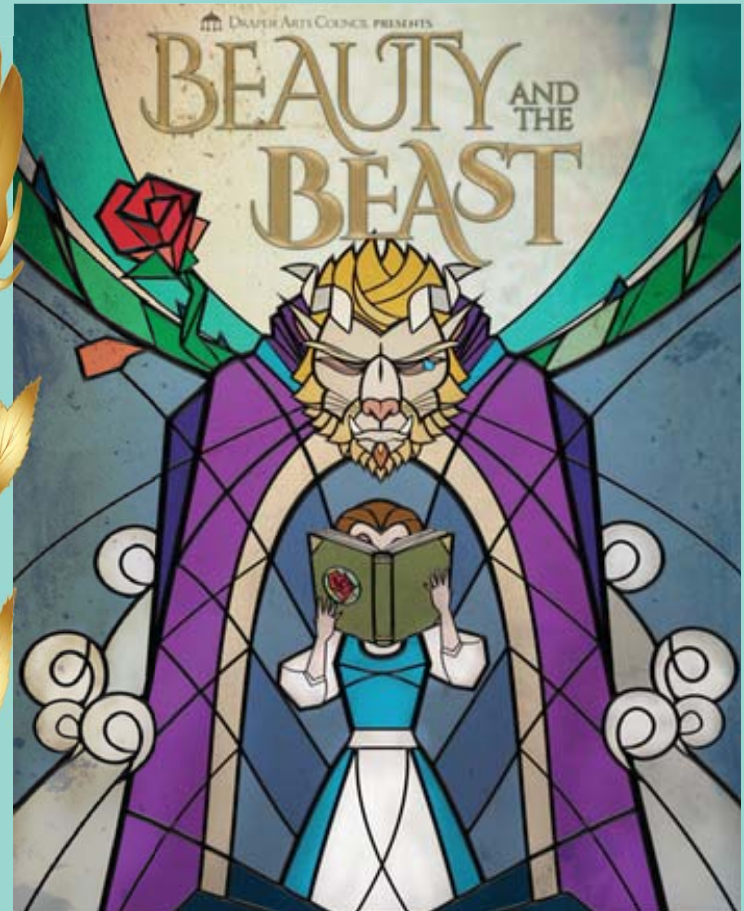

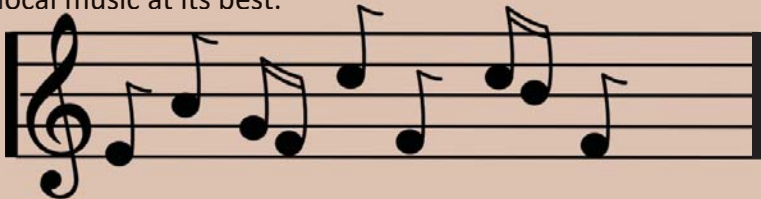

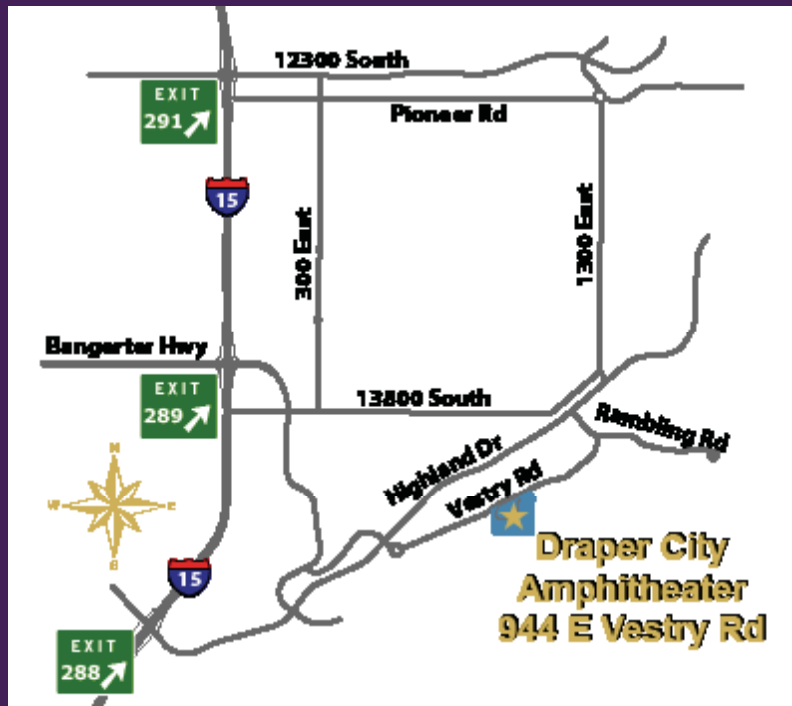

- *Bring a blanket or lawn chair to sit on if you are sitting in the grass tier area. Each ticket in the tier section corresponds to a spot about 21 inches wide.*
- *This is an outdoor venue. Bring a jacket or raincoat as needed. You might also consider insect repellent and allergy medication.*
- *The show will go on rain or shine!*
- *Seating will begin approximately 60 minutes before the show starts. Draper Arts Council performances open 30 minutes before show starts.*
- *For the quickest entry, come prepared to show your ticket barcodes printed on paper or displayed on your phone.*
- *All ticket sales are final. No exchanges and no refunds.*
