Protect Yourself from Porch Pirates



As the holiday season gets underway, the number of package deliveries across the U.S. rises. FedEx and UPS delivered more than 1 billion packages between Black Friday and Christmas Day in 2016.

For anyone waiting on Black Friday, Cyber Monday, or Christmas deliveries, this is the time to be extra vigilant.

In 2016, August Home Inc. reported an estimated 11 million Americans had a package stolen during the year. Unsurprisingly, close to 75% of packages are stolen during the day when the recipient is not home.

Check out tips on how to avoid package theft and give yourself some peace of mind. •

Avoid Package Theft

- Leave a note specifying where you'd like your package left.
- Have packages delivered to your workplace.
- Track when your packages are delivered.
- Request a signature for delivery.
- Buy a lockable parcel box for your porch.
- Have packages delivered to a friend or family member.
- Don't leave packages outside. Pick them up immediately.

Keep Your Car Safe in Cold Weather
